

### **PRIMARY**

Person is diagnosed with COVID-19 or is considered a presumptive case(symptoms). ISOLATE FROM OTHERS:

- Follow health professional recommendations.
- ISOLATE UNTIL 10 DAYS from onset of symptoms or when tested AND no fever for 24 hours and symptoms improving.

#### **IDENTIFY/NOTIFY:**

Notify all persons you have been in contact with for 72 hours prior to onset of symptoms or positive test.



## PRIMARY EXPOSURE

Person who has direct contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is considered a presumptive case.

### QUARANTINE:

- Begin quarantine immediately for 14 days.
- Self-monitor for symptoms or fever.
- Contact your physician regarding getting tested.

If you are positive, then follow PRIMARY protocol.

### IDENTIFY/NOTIFY:

Notify all persons you have been in contact with for 72 hours prior that you are a PRIMARY EXPOSURE. They should follow SECONDARY EXPOSURE protocol.





## **SECONDARY EXPOSURE**

Person is in direct contact with a Primary Exposure person.

### NO QUARANTINE:

- Self-monitor for fevers.
- If PRIMARY CONTACT test positive or diagnosed as presumptive case, follow PRIMARY EXPOSURE protocol.

### **IDENTIFY/NOTIFY:**

Notify all persons you have been in contact with that you will notify them if you develop symptoms or become a PRIMARY EXPOSURE. They should follow Tertiary Exposure protocol.







# TERTIARY EXPOSURE

Person is in direct contact with a Secondary Exposure.

### NO ACTION

No action needed unless you move to Secondary Exposure.

KEEP COMMUNICATIONS OPEN, PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING, WEAR A MASK, AND USE FREQUENT AND THOROUGH HAND HYGEINE.

**Direct Contact** 1. Within 6 ft of someone who has COVD-19(or suspected) for a total of 15 minutes or more from 2 days prior to symptom onset until end of home isolation. 2. You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19. 3. You had direct physical contact with the person who is positive or suspected positive (hugged or kissed). 4. You shared eating or drinking utensils. 5. They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you.
